This year as well as having the normal competitions (these dates are on the left) we will also have 3 Challenge days, these days will consist of various fun golfing activities which will all be organised by Julie, so put them on your calendar so you don't miss them, a poster will go up in the pro-shop and on the Junior notice board with further information, the dates for your diary are as follows

The coaching will start again on Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> March through to Sept but this time there will be a difference, the coaching will take on a whole new meaning in that we will assess you on your abilities this year and if you pass you will be awarded a certificate, this is brand new and we will let you all know nearer the time what it all involves. Again we will have 6 week coaching sessions and these will be payable to Julie at a Cost of £24, which is excellent value for the coaching that is given, these sessions will have no more than 6 – 8 players in each group, again we will put a notice on the board of who is in each session.

Please look at the notice board because I will be placing weekly planners on there so you don't miss a thing, I will also be placing relevant competition info on there so you can put your name down so we know who are playing, once we have all the names we will put out a list of who's playing with who and at what time and again this will be on the notice board.



## Phoenix Golf Club Pre-Junior Newsletter Jan 2011

There will be Wednesdays when there's no coaching or Medals, this is because the Phoenix Men's 1<sup>st</sup> team will be playing, however the practice area will still be open and you can still come up after 5.15pm.

Something we would like to do this year at least a couple of times is have a divot filling night, where we go out on the course this time without our clubs and we fill in all the divots... please watch the notice board for dates and times.

We are also introducing something which is really just a bit of fun, we are going to introduce 2 pre-junior captains during a year, the 1<sup>st</sup> will run from Jan 1<sup>st</sup> – 30<sup>th</sup> June, the 2<sup>nd</sup> will run from July 1<sup>st</sup> to 31<sup>st</sup> December.

The first Pre-Junior Captains will be Brandon Perry then Harrison Naylor, please note however that the main Junior Captain is Matthew Renwick and you all should look up to him and give him your total support throughout the year.

On the 20<sup>th</sup> March, we will hold a Pre-Junior Handicap day where new Pre-Juniors will gain their handicap off the blue tees, and established Pre-Juniors will be handicapped off the red tees, we may promote these red tee players during the year from red to yellow tees dependant on how these players are developing.

The established Pre-Juniors will no longer have caddie's or parents walking with them, all parents will not be able to carry the bags of their children nor help their children in any way, to this we will introduce a min of a 50 yard distance rule between the player and their parent, this is to encourage the golfers to think and play for themselves and is the next step in their development. We will however ask parents to take note of how many shots players take and see if it's the same as the players when they hand their cards in.
